Alec Zeck (<u>00:00:30</u>):

Eric, thank you so much for joining me. So I remember back at the beginning of this, this whole situation, I was following various Reddit subs that were and, and this was in December of 2019, that were, they were showing Chinese people dropping dead in the streets, and, you know, early talks of a so-called lab leak, which I know we'll get to later during this event. But for the, for this session, we're going to be talking about the true origin story of Covid. And you woke up on, on March 3rd with a little whisper in your ear telling you to get to the bottom of this and to really understand PCR. So, I'll the test, I'll turn it over to you. Yeah, yeah. I'll turn it over to you. Test. That's

All I thought I was looking into was the test and hi everyone. So, but I, I also have a kind of a plan, a way of tradition of doing news chronologies. We like doing news chronologies, so, so, you know, and other parts of my day, I'm an astrologer, and so we do a lot of day keeping day, day, just what happened that day. And so so on March 3rd is part of my assignment, let's say, to understand the test. We also began a news chronology now on day 1,149. I can say that we all know that this was a planned event. And so therefore, once you know that, once you know that it's a planned event everything becomes part of that plan. All right. So these, so there, so at the, at the beginning, the, it was, it was kind of like Hunger Games.

They had four different teams on the hunt for for, for the virus. That is to say, four different teams assigned with the task of making up the virus. So this, this was really a, a game of throwing shit against the wall and see what sticks. And so the, the first team we've heard of, that's the fan woo team, and they come up with what most people consider to be the first sequence. We don't know who the purple team was. Then there was the zoo team and I believe that, okay, there was the zoo team, then there was the e the, the should be more famous than it is Lili Ren team. Which comes up with what I believe was the virus template. It's still not totally refined in the chronology. It's very hard to keep this stuff straight. And then the Z team and the Zow team is also with the the, the guy on event 2 0 1. Got it. So bright.

Let's see if I can find his name. George Gal. So it's Gal Zoo, the, the the Gal Zoo thing. And so the, the Gazoo team. So the thing is that, we'll, we're gonna go, we're gonna start in October and walk through this. But just to give you an idea of how complicated this is, and look at all these other sequences. And all of this is all going on December, January, yeah. December January. Some of it in late 2019. These are collection dates. Mm-Hmm. <affirmative>, right? Where they, you know, they shove the thing off somebody's butt and take a perfectly pure sample. But they're not the publication dates. And my understanding is that the Ren team, which is also the vision medicals team of Little Dog Paper fame, have heard of this thing. No. Little dog paper. Yeah. So the Little Dog paper was published on Medium in, in December.

And mark figured out Mark Bailey, and I consulted him with him on this. 'cause I was one of the only people who really knew about this thing. Me and me and my unnamed virus guy. I've got a virus guy who's on the ground looking at all this stuff. Mark, mark proposed the hypothesis that the little wr, little rin, little WinDor mountain dog paper was complete Chinese propaganda. Wow. w which was designed to convince the world that China was working assiduously night and day to stop the virus, and blah, blah, blah. So it's a very complicated job. And just to cut it to the chase of that the, the first the first sequence claimed sequence, always remember, these are claimed sequences. None of these are viruses. None of these are whole virus. None of these are part of a virus. None of these have ever been shown to come from a virus. Simply just proclaimed

Sequences that are claimed to be coming from

Eric Coppolino (<u>00:05:57</u>):

Particles, but they've never been shown to confirm a virus, match a virus or cause a disease ever. None of them. So the whole thing is just a bunch of hogwash right from the get go. But the vision medicals team that's, say the Lely Ren team with an impressive list of sponsors, hopefully I've got that handy. No, Jeff has the list of sponsors, but the list of sponsors looks like Enron. Like you ever see the Enron charts with like Donald Duck, L I c, and you know, Oscar, the Grouch, I I c and all this, that's what the Ren team's financial hierarchy looks like. Mm-Hmm. So they published the first genome, 4 0 2 1 2 3 claim genome metagenomic transcript, but they don't publish a paper until May. And the paper by Ren at al has all the disclosures. The disclosures bring in Johns Hopkins. So right from the get go on the, on the first, in the, in the very first four claims sequences, W Zoo, Ren, and Z Goo, none of this helps native English speakers because it's all a bunch of Chinese words, which are all very short. Conveniently, they think our names are way too long. The two of them come back right away to Hopkins. And well, Hopkins and Hopkins this is

Also significant because Johns Hopkins was linked. I think they were the ones running the event. 2 0 1 expert.

Eric Coppolino (00:07:34):

That's right. It was hop it was Hopkins Gates and, and World Economic Forum. Yeah. running this thing. We'll, we'll get to, we're gonna start at event 2 0 1. So if we go back to event 2 0 1, this is oc this is an OCT October, 2019. This was a tabletop rehearsal for a, the world's first ever global Coronavirus pandemic. And they, they drill everything. They talk about not only social media censoring, they talk

about shutting down the internet itself to prevent the spread of so-called misinformation, shutting down the internet choosing which industries are essential and non-essential, shutting down whole sectors of the economy. All of this is what was drilled at Event 2 0 1. The only thing that I know of that wasn't drilled was how to take care of a sick person. And the thing I find the most galling and all the coverage of ev event of, of, of the entire COVID scenario was, I have yet to see, certainly not in 20 20 20 or or anywhere near it, a simple article on how to take care of your kid or your wife or your girlfriend.

If she's sick, what do you do? So this was a, a plan <laugh>, it was a plan for a pandemic that just happened to skip over the part about taking care of sick people. This shows the, the moral depravity and the pure financial in interests that were that work here. Okay? So then the World Military Games is held in Wuhan at the end of, at the end of October, which becomes Patsy number one. The, that was the just like AIDS was blamed on the bicentennial celebration in New York City when all the patriotic gay men who wanted to party their asses off in 1976 falsely was blamed for spreading aids, Gaetan, duga, blah, blah. The world Military games was coming up frequently at the beginning of this as being like, oh, it was World Military Games. Look, they brought it back to every country.

So the, it's hard to imagine all of that being pre-planned. You and I both know how long it would take to plan the world's military games. For sure. They're probably, those games probably being planned 10 years earlier. The committee was probably on the ground in, in Wuhan five years ahead. So it's not like they could have just made it up on the spot, but it was certainly convenient. It was, yeah. Never was an opportunity. Oh, never waste an opportunity. No one was the perfect tool during, during the, during the games, which no one knew was were happening. 'cause No one had heard of Wuhan before this. Unless you, you know, your Chinese, local Chinese restaurant is like Wuhan Noodle shop. The Future of Health Summit takes place in Washington, DC And by the way, Mike, Mike Bryant could, could give like 50 Ted Talks on this without notes.

The Future of Health Summit takes place in Washington. And on, on the 29th, I think a Sunday night, Fauci takes part in a panel with five other flu experts, a whole bunch of NGOs and injection pushers. And they, they say out loud to the C-span audience on one of these panels that, like, if you were, if you were feeling like you couldn't sleep at three in the morning, you'd turn on C-span, probably C-span, two or three, and you'd fall asleep. Well, this one was more interesting than all that they admit that they, they, that they need to make the flu seem, Fauci says this as dangerous and as scary as aids in cancer. That's the one to have the public perception. Fauci in this thing admits their focus, grouping diseases, focus grouping. They're doing something. They probably hired Luntz personally to do this.

I don't know that for a fact. But Lu Frank Luntz the guy I came up with, death tax, climate change, all that. The, he, he's the the, the genius messaging guy. I think his thumbprints are all over this thing. In terms of kill grandma, social distance, all these things that we were, all the words we were saying over and over again. They, they are so clever and catchy that I just, I was seeing lunch flash before my eyes, which is not a very pretty site all, all through 2020. Like, kill grandma. Who the hell thought of that? So at this summit, they announced that they are going to roll out the mRNA vaccine, but at the time, they were calling it the Universal Flu Shot. They did not call it Covid shot. And they were complaining about the miserable market. Saturation of the flu shot a mere 23%.

So they needed they, and they, and using too many eggs. And, which is partly I think why eggs are so expensive right now. That, but even though the hot shot of the day is not an egg-based vaccine they were saying, nah, we, we don't like these egg egg vaccines anymore. We need to do this using digital technology. So remember, this is on, they announced this to the world two weeks after event 2 0 1, which no one had heard of, and then hardly anyone. And then they come out with this announcement on CSPAN on 10 29. By the way, at the Milken Institute, Michael Milken of junk bond fame, felon, felon, financial conspirator of the Milken Institute is basically designed as kind of greenwashing, the Milken family name. That's where they're holding this at a place named after one of the biggest financial scammers of the 1980s. Wow. Yes. Milken, who, who heard all old people, old, old, old people who read newspapers. So so then it's only a month between there and their claim first patient. So, you know, oh, by the way, I mean, talk about setup. November 7th, the next pandemic appears featuring Bill Gates. So twice Netflix was used as a platform to roll out the, the, the narrative Gates

Alec Zeck (00:13:57):

Know so much has happened the last three years that I had completely forgot about this. But this is so right, this, I remember my wife and I seeing this pull up on Netflix, and we were like, what the heck is this?

Eric Coppolino (00:14:08):

Yeah, this is why the chronology is so, is such a trip basically. And, and putting this stuff together was mind boggling. So the next pandemic, and this is one of two, two times Netflix was used to feed, feed this massive psychological operation. So there, there, there's there's Mr. Gates and all's glory. Okay? So in December, here is the symptom onset date of the first person claimed to have suffer from a disease, but none of it by acclaim virus. They didn't have a name for it. But none of the index patients, family members developed fever. Any other respiratory symptoms? No epidemiological link was found. No one had any contact with the, with the market, but they claimed that he had was the first person with this virus. Now he is, to my knowledge, not the unidentified 61 year old patient used used by the fan Wu team, the, the fan Wu team.

We'll get to there, we'll get there, we'll get there. So also of, of of great importance, on the same day, China passes a new vaccine law, the Vaccine administration law, which essentially was to ban black market vaccines. So China's, China's like, on one hand it's completely totalitarian. On the other hand it's the wild West. And so there were a lot of expats in particular who were going to like boutique vaccine clinics. And, you know, getting in <laugh>, getting injected with like mystery juice. God knows what. So here, you know, here's interesting one that I cannot trace back to its original source, but we have the quote a newspaper called The Citizen in New Zealand, the Chinese Ambassador to South Africa. Chen Zong said the local government in China got the first Covid report on December 29, second December 2nd, 2019, they got samples of the first Covid patients on the 30th. I'm not sure whether that's 30th of November or the 30th of of, of December. But no one should be talking about anyone or anything on December 2nd. Nobody has any way to know anything that's going on unless you were in the plan.

So the, the reason why the vaccine law is so important is to my thinking, because these vaccines make people sick. And they, and this is centered, a lot of it is in, is in Wuhan. Okay? So there's AGL Global Vaccine Summit on the second that was long planned in Geneva. They're having a lot of, they're always having meetings in Switzerland. Impeachment hearings begin involving the Ukraine affair on the fourth. So this is the, the American public is riveted to Adam Schiff, pharmaceutical rep senator from the

pharmaceutical companies, Adam Schiff, holding these good looking on their face hear hearings, right? Everybody was all riled up about this. So then from here on, it's pretty much straight propaganda. The, the, the N I H timeline is rife with all kinds of claims and people rushing the hospitals in, in, in, in Wuhan. And the, and the thing that's clear, once you actually look at the numbers, and you actually look at what is documented besides these generic statements, is there was not an outbreak of anything in China. There was only a lockdown in China.

So, so then all through the month of December, you're hearing 41 cases. 41 cases 40. Can you see that? 41 cases? Yep. 41 cases. Okay. 41 cases. They, that number holds steady pretty much through the beginning of 2020. Now, this is crazy. Now we, we've so here's crazy this on December 9th, John o Looney, who we've met previously, he's the whistleblowing mortician in England. And he checked his mortuary log for me. And he said that he went to pick up a body, Mr. Jones, I called him in the American ary industry industry at, at a hospital, specifically Northampton General. And in, in hospitals in England, they have what are called rest chapels. Maybe they've got an equivalent in the United States, but it's almost like a funeral home in the hospital where they move a recently deceased person so the person can be with their loved one's body in arrest chapel in the hospital.

And he went by one of those. And the whole thing was in biohazard, it was dressed up as biohazard. And and this is on the 9th of December. There's absolutely no reason for this. And he said, in 16 years of picking up deceased individuals, it was the first time he'd ever seen such a thing in 16 years. As he, he makes the fu he makes the hospital runs himself. They don't have drivers to it. He goes and fetches the, the, the, his patients, his clients himself. And he said that this, the d c passed away on November 27th, and they would not allow the family time to visit. They contacted me some days later and I collected their loved one, a woman on the 9th of December. And that's when he saw this and they would not let them visit. So this is in early December of 2019.

So, so the word was leaking out in England. And England becomes a central place where this whole story is planted for several reasons that we'll we'll see when we go out about five or six more weeks. So now they go through this routine of, you know, more people sick, more people sick, blah, blah, blah. And one document I have on December 11th, virologists are claiming to have 200 variants of a virus that hasn't been named, and from which nobody has known to have died. 200 variants on December 11th, 2019. I mean, talk about throwing enough shit against the wall. And so this, we can skip this editor's note here. So now there's, now on the 12th, there's 59 patients. This is still not, you know, as Gerald, Gerald Ty's trans journal said from from January, it said like you know, 59 patients sick with sick with the flu, 1.2 billion. Okay?

Alec Zeck (00:21:11):

And when they say unexplained viral pneumonia, I would imagine if it's not just conjecture speculation, the unexplained, what they're likely referring to in that case, I would imagine is that they, they tested one or maybe some of these people for so-called known viruses.

Eric Coppolino (<u>00:21:32</u>):
Oh yeah. And,
Alec Zeck (<u>00:21:33</u>):

And they came back negative for so-called known viruses as if that's the only cause of pneumonia, which is an absurd presupposition absurd of itself. And thank you. They're like, oh, we need to sequence the genetic material.

Eric Coppolino (00:21:45):

That is, that is great. That answers the question how it's unexplained. I've got, I've got that editor's note there. So I should, I'm, you get, you're gonna get a little footnote in there. You're explaining the unexplained, alright, so house judiciary committee, blah, blah, blah, they're ramping up the impeachment they're ramping it up, right? So you gotta remember, the entire American public is riveted by this Trump derangement syndrome is at it's all time high. People think finally one of the bad guys is getting his comeuppance. And you know, there, there, there's not a a, a Twitter in the world that's not tuned, at least in the States. Okay? So, so here's where we start getting into the sampling. Here's where we start getting into the weeds of who and what all this is about. So they're taking samples here on the 21st.

There's an incident drill on the 23rd. Now, one thing in my long history of covering non-existent false flag incidents is you, you, your clue of false flag is always the drill. There's always a drill. There was a NORAD drill on September 11th, 2001, consisting of four hijacked airplanes. There was a drill on seven seven in London involving the same four metro stations where there were incidents on seven seven, there was a drill on seven seven. So what ha this, the, the f fact of the drill allows them to the purveyors of these things to confuse participants so that the participants think they're preparing for a drill. It's kinda like Enders game. They, they think it's a game, but it's reality. And so that's how they, that's how they handle one of the need to know situations. Okay? So now, I, I am not there, there are, I'm still ironing out inconsistencies in this.

And after like two and a half years, I thought, all right, let's give it a rest. So and there are diversity of sources and some of the sources conflict, and you have to do a lot of sorting it out. I mean, this is complicated, right? There's no really getting to the bottom of this. And I, and I, I think that they're all kind of confused about what was going on too. But the reported sampling day for M 9 0 8 9 4 7, that is to say the fan woo, patient is on, on this date. But the conflict comes in when David Rasnick explains that this, this claimed first index patient was very sick, but it might've been a 61 year old. So, we'll, we'll, again, you know, I have not been able to ni pin all of this down, but the important thing to remember is none of it's true. It's, it's all just public relations. It's all just set up to have something to have scientific papers on file that they can just hang their coat on. So, so there's this 1 41 year old patient who may end up as M 9 0 8 9 4 7, okay? Now, at the end of the year the, the n I H is claiming four cases linked to the wet market claim to have been the source of the virus.

Alec Zeck (00:25:23):

And that's the n i h in the us,

Eric Coppolino (<u>00:25:24</u>):

Correct? Yeah. Yep. National Institute of Health. Now, here, I think is an essential piece of propaganda. Dr. Lee Wang Lang an an eye surgeon in Wuhan sees the, he's the guy who sends a message to medic medics saying There's seven cases of sars of Wuhan Hospital all connected to the market. He is, he is called up by the Chinese Communist Party. He is censured. And then he's last seen wearing oxygen and dying. And he becomes the first face, he, he becomes the first face of Covid.

Alec Zeck (00:26:01):

I wanna make a point here. So this situation with Dr. Lee, I remember this specifically because from the more conspiratorial, you know, alternative side, it seemed like they intentionally, they being the Chinese Communist Party intentionally killed this guy because many of us thought he was telling quote true information, right? Because at the same time, this is ac accompanied by the, what I now consider to be propaganda of Chinese people dropping dead in the streets, right? Mm-Hmm. <affirmative>. And at the same time, the US media wasn't really covering this. There was, there was very scamp like minimal coverage of this situation, which I, at the time and many other people took as, oh my God, the US media isn't covering this because they're trying to cover up that there was a virus that was made in a lab in Wuhan. And this Dr. Lee is being intentionally killed. Because it seems as if he's starting to, to sort of lend credence to that idea. And that's, that's what was sort of in the minds of much of the alternative side at this point in time, while this is happening in the mainstream, which I just think is a really interesting thing when it comes to the, the propaganda behind this whole situation.

Eric Coppolino (<u>00:27:24</u>):

Yeah. And I think that now every last thing is suspect as propaganda. So now the, the number now, you see, like, have in bold here the different numbers. There's a lot of conflicts in the there's a lot of conflicts in the numbers, right? But the number 44 cases keeps coming back. 41 44, you see that? Keep repeating mm-hmm. <Affirmative> back up to 44 cases on, on the 30th. Now we're on the, the 31st. The first the first claim of censorship on y y content was censored. A broad scope of censored c Ovid 19 con content wasn't called C Ovid 19 then, but it was

Alec Zeck (<u>00:28:13</u>):

Novel coronavirus, something to that effect. Yeah,

Eric Coppolino (<u>00:28:15</u>):

This is, so this is ex post will Bill Houston hates when the thing is called C Ovid 19 before it is, is that, but this is just quoting something slightly retroactively saying that they were suppressing so suppressing the truth. So my observation at the end of 2019 is the claimed early cases were random and not clusters, families, villages, or people with actual documented contact with one another. And where there is contact, it's often there's no spread. The claim of community spread is taken seriously though, right? This is somehow taken seriously, even though there, there isn't any. And the, the first claim point source is the market. And that's said to be a super spreader event. Now, very quickly on, we'll get, we'll get to how the market theory is, is demolished, and how the lab leak takes over in January in, in the public. Now mind you, this was also in late December. No one remembers this, but this was in Australia was on fire. They were, I had clients down there writing to me and, and telling me they were locked in their houses with air filters on because the, the whole swath of the country was on fire.

It's always interesting to look at what was not going on. Then there's Chinese New Year, that's later in the month. Oh, it was on the 25th. Ah, so there was a, a full moon that weekend. All right? So January 1st, until this date, the number of people reported remains unknown, but consensus is around 41. So keep watching that number. 41, 41. Now, you would think by this time, you know, they're about to declare a global pandemic. They can do better than 41. 41 people are sick in one, in one country, in one city with 10 million people with more, more air pollution than, you know, queens known pathogen ruled out by China. It must be a novel virus. So one thing we keep forgetting is, and I, I know that we're under

globalism and all of that, but that this looks to me like economic warfare by China against the United States, with the use of conspirators in the United States.

I mean, I have very simple theory of this, which is, was just a, it was, it was China nuking us without any nukes and all, all they needed, they already owned. We, we were already wondering what they were gonna do with all this shit they owned in the, in the United States. Well, now we're seeing what they do with it, like zoom and everything. So and, and then they're, they're in with, with Hopkins and, and w e f this whole thing is, is multinationals, but it's all born. The story comes out of China, which means it is all about the C C P. This is incredibly important to, to, to remind, remember. Okay, so now there's a lot of inside baseball here. So he, here, this is I'm still sorting this out. Gen Bank receives, but doesn't publish. The first receives a claim, viral sequence, MN 9 0 8 9 4 7. This is the famous sequence cited by the C D C to this day, and the f d A and cited by Corman and Roston to this day, right in the, well, that, that paper's kind of dead in the water, but still, they, they mention it and it's still, and,

Alec Zeck (<u>00:31:48</u>):

And for those who are watching the, the Corman Roston paper real quick is, is the paper that set the precedent for the testing protocol for virtually the entire

Eric Coppolino (<u>00:31:59</u>):

World? Yeah, we'll get there in a second. We're, we're coming. It's only two weeks away. And then basically the story's over on January 31st, in my opinion, E everything that was said was said, and everything that could be done was done, and it's all reruns after January 31st. So Gen bank gets this sequence, but it's kept quiet. And then, okay, now this is worth here. This will give you an idea of how complicated this is. So this is from my sequencing editor who, who doesn't like to be talked about? 41 year old patient sampled for the fan. Woo paper. The woo paper, the woo paper is MN 9 0 8 9 4 7 is not the same one for the Ren paper. They both have 41 year old male patients. But they're in different hospitals, different admission dates and so forth. And I have a theory why they're, why they're doing all this concerning the Ren sequences. Lili Ren, it's not completely clear from which patient the original sample comes. There are five patients and five sequences numbered one to five. So the logical conclusion is that sequence one comes from patient one, but maybe not.

They refer to patients four and five as if the first sequence would contain mostly patient four reads and a little bit of patient five reads. So you don't know that you don't know what they're doing. Th this is not, there's no chain of custody on these samples. Samples without chain of custody are invalid. I, I can't just send dirt to a lab and claim he came from East Palestine. I've gotta have proof that he came from East Palestine. There's gotta be at least the semblance of proof. Somebody videotaping the sample. And a couple of witnesses, father McGill Cudi, you know, rabbi Schloss, and they all sign a thing that says, yes, we witnessed some weird astrologer, investigative reporter taking these samples. They videotape it, and then they march to the FedEx place and they send them, nah, that's what we required of us for them. Nah, whatever. Maybe a little bit of patient one, maybe a little patient four, a little patient, five, a little monkey puss, a little cow puss, a little poison here, an antibiotic there in Presto change. You've got a virus. So now <laugh>, now it's already, we're already into January, and they're still talking 59 patients, 44 cases, 11 patients are ill, but 33 are stable. Nobody's died. What is the big deal?

Alec Zeck (00:34:51):

I mean, this, this is, this is over a month later at this point from the initial so-called outbreak and the initial patients. And there, there, there's nothing. And especially what stuck out to me here is that one of the initial patients, none of his family members developed any sort of disease symptoms. That's the

Eric Coppolino (00:35:12):

First one. They were all fine. Yeah. Yeah. I mean, but this is as ridiculous as testing negative 18 times. And being said, you're positive. Yeah, we, we are just in com. A completely upside down existence here. Okay? So January 7th, rigorous test. No other practices successfully identify the virus. Come on. This is Mad Magazine. This is not, this is like a parody. Okay? So here, Rasnick chimes in. I had to can you give a little background on who Dave Ra Rasnick is? Yeah. So Rasnick was one of the first people to work on AIDS drugs, and then he realized the whole thing was a scam. And and is, is I don't know exactly what his relationship to the Perth group was, but he's one of the early people who figured out that there, there was no h I V virus and there was no outbreak of H I V and his interviews on the subject or, or Grayden.

(00:36:14):

He's the one who talks about AIDS topic at the end of his zip code, which it shouldn't do just like, you know, just like the, the, the deaths from so-called Covid in, in New York City, stop at the Bronx line. And, and, and I'm, I'm in a, I'm in the outermost suburb of New York City, and there were buses running all through March and April, or certainly February and March, and there was nothing going on up here. And if there was some kind of a super spreading thing, then all, all those commuters on, on the bus that, you know, there, there should have been you know, carnage appeared, but no.
